

## *Hutchinson Camp Rollcall*

The following men are confirmed to have been interned at Hutchinson camp. This list records each man's date of birth, occupation and the official date of their release. In most cases the occupation is listed as it appears on the original record, unless archaic, in which case the modern equivalent is used (e.g., 'fruit-seller' for 'fruiterer', or 'travelling salesman' for 'commercial traveller').

This information is drawn from dozens of first-hand accounts, surviving lists of speakers for the camp Cultural Department, theatrical programmes, issues of *The Camp* newspaper, MI5 files and other documentation. Details have subsequently been verified with the official British Home Office records. Additionally, each of the 21,208 pages held in the National Archive files HO 396/245 (internee surnames beginning 'A') through to HO 396/283 (internee surnames beginning 'Y-Z') have been checked for markings that indicate an individual was specifically interned at Hutchinson, identified below by the letter 'H'.

HLS. – Mentioned in papers of Rabbi Solomon Schonfeld, Hartley Library, University of Southampton.

Reinterned – Where an individual was arrested for a second time, the final date of release is used.

Schwitters. – portrait painted or drawn by Kurt Schwitters.

STL. – Stateless case.

TC. – Contributor to, or mentioned in, *The Camp* newspaper.

UD. – Mentioned in Uhlman Diaries.

W. – Identified by MI5 as a 'friend of Warschauer'.
